#### OFFICIAL RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE FLOAT COMPETITION

- All competing floats must be designed around one of this year's themes:
   A. "CIRCUS DAYS"
   B. "WILD WEST"
- 2. Floats report for judging at St. Mary's Church parking lot, South 18th Street at 6:00 P.M. parade evening.
- 3. Parade route and your position in the parade will be sent to you in separate instructions.
- 4. An official score sheet will be used to judge all floats, with a large number of points going toward the integration of float motif with the selected theme. Emphasis should be placed on the unique, animations, humorous or crowd appeal aspects of each float.

FLOATS WILL BE JUDGED ON THE FOLLOWING OFFICIAL BASIS:

THEME AND ADHERENCE A maximum of 30 points will be given with emphasis placed on the theme, imagination, simplicity, clarity of expression and adherence to theme. Does the theme adequately and simply develop?

EYE APPEAL...... A maximum of 10 points. Is the float impressive and striking?

BALANCE......A maximum of 10 points. Does the float have good overall balance as for as bulkiness, barren spots and over-loaded construction is concerned?

COLOR COMBINATION....A maximum of 10 points. Does the float have complimentary contrasting color scheme?

WORKMANSHIP AND.MATERIALS.....A combined five points for workmanship & five points for materials. Is good workmanship evident? Is float of attractive materials?

EXTRA ATTRACTIVE.....A maximum of 10 points. Does float have uniqueness, animation or qualities of crowd appeal?

BONUS POINTS.......A maximum of 20 points for crowd response as float passes judging stand on the street of the parade route.

TOTAL = 100 POINTS

1ST, 2ND, and 3RD PLACE TROPHIES WILL BE AWARDED TO EACH THEME CATEGORY, PLUS THE POTENTATE'S TROPHY FOR THE BEST FLOAT OF ALL THE PARADE.
